We are pleased to announce that the Environmental Assessment (EA) and Section 4(f) Evaluation for the Green Line Extension project is now available for public review. MassDOT and the MBTA are applying for federal funding to support the costs of designing and constructing the Green Line Extension project and the EA is part of the Federal Transit Administration environmental review process.

On October 20, 2011, there will be a Public Hearing at which members of the public are invited to provide comments on the EA. At the Hearing, participants may either submit written comments or provide spoken testimony. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation will also be taking public comments on suggested interim offset mitigation measures needed to compensate for any delay in the implementation of the Green Line Extension Project. Project staff will be available during an Open House prior to the Hearing to answer questions.
