Parking for 51 Winthrop

There are a number of options for parking:

- On Boston Avenue
- Along Capen Street Extension, a one-way street a block up from 51 Winthrop, which you can enter from University Avenue
- Dowling Parking Garage: There is plenty of parking available in the University's main parking garage on Boston Avenue. Visitors must purchase a token (\$5.00) to exit the garage. The entrances to the garage are from North Hill Road and from Boston Avenue. The garage is open from 6:00 AM to 12 midnight.
- In surface lots: Miller Hall lot (which is behind Carmichael Hall on Winthrop Street) or Hill Hall surface lot, on University Avenue, off Boston Avenue.

Tufts Public Safety staff has been alerted to our meeting and will not ticket the surface lots or Capen Street Extension. We recommend looking at the Tufts Campus Parking map in advance to make your trip easier.
